

Lesson 7: Low-Cost and Tuition-Free Colleges

Objective:
Students will learn about low-cost and tuition-free colleges and the populations they serve.
Overview:
Students will explore links to a number of tuition-free and low-cost colleges.

Lesson preparation:	Activity
<p>Teacher and students will need access to the internet.</p> <p>Open the PowerPoint for Lesson 7. Print copies of the Lesson 7 pre-test and post-test.</p> <p>Print copies of the Lesson 7 Handout if you plan to present the lesson offline or create digital template in Google Docs or comparable online platform. Modify format and fields as desired. If presenting as a jigsaw activity, print and separate cards attached to handout or create cards with names of colleges to distribute among students.</p> <p>Go to http://aspirations.sparc37.com/ and click on the Finances link at the bottom. This takes you to links for tuition-free and low-cost colleges These are the links students will explore in this lesson.</p>	<p>Distribute copies of the pre-test, ask students to complete, and collect pre-tests. The pre-test will let students know what they should learn from this lesson.</p> <p>Review the PowerPoint with students. You may need to revisit slides as you conduct the lesson activities.</p> <p>Go to http://aspirations.sparc37.com/ and click on the Finances link at the bottom. This takes you to a series of links for tuition-free and low-cost colleges. Locate the link for College Scorecard. These are the links students will explore in this lesson.</p> <p>Provide students with printed or online template to facilitate collection of information about tuition-free and low-cost colleges. If presenting lesson as a jigsaw activity, assign different colleges to individual or small groups of students. Conclude lesson with brief oral presentations about each college.</p> <p>Distribute copies of the post-test, ask students to complete, and collect post-tests. Compare pre- and post-test results.</p>

Suggestions for Differentiation:	Discussion:
<p>Google Chrome is the suggested browser if language translation is required. Simply right-click anywhere on the page and choose the "Translate" option.
